AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF SHIP BOTTOM, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY PROVIDING FOR PURCHASE OF BODY WORN CAMERAS, AND APPROPRIATING \$80,000 THEREFOR FROM THE BOROUGH'S GENERAL CAPITAL FUND BALANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF SHIP BOTTOM, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The sum of \$80,000 is hereby appropriated from the Borough of Ship Bottom, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Borough") Capital Improvement Fund is for the purchase of vehicles, including all work and materials necessary therefore or incidental thereto.

Section 2. The capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. In the event of any such inconsistency and amendment, the resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget, as applicable, and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
