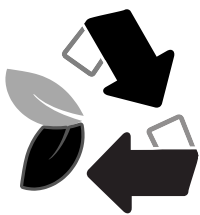

TRASH/GARBAGE CONTAINERS:

Shall be placed curbside before 5:00 am on your scheduled day. Containers must be watertight with lids. Containers no larger than 32 gallons, weight not over 85 lbs. Every property allowed six (6) containers. Lids cannot be fastened to container. **ALL TRASH MUST BE IN A CONTAINER.**

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING CONTAINERS:

Containers are collected curbside and must be clearly marked with a recycle decal. Aluminum cans, glass containers, plastic bottles, newspapers, junk mail and cardboard all in one container. **No plastic bags for comingled materials.** Do not tie papers or cardboard. Please remove bottle caps.

REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS/AIR CONDITIONERS:

Purchase Freon sticker from Borough Hall and place sticker on unit curbside. Doors must be removed from refrigerators and freezers. Picked up year round.

BULK TRASH:

Large items and furniture will be picked up curbside from September through June.

WHITE GOODS & ALL METAL:

White goods and all metals can be placed curbside anytime year round.

PROPANE TANKS:

Must be disposed of privately by owner.

ALUMINUM CANS, GLASS CONTAINERS, PLASTIC:

Do not put in plastic bags. All co-mingled materials shall be placed in a properly labeled recycling container.

BRUSH & CLIPPINGS:

Brush must be bundled and tied in 4 foot lengths or less, weighing no more than 40 lbs. Limbs cannot be more than 3-1/2 inches in diameter. Small brush, leaves and/or pine needles must be in bags and placed in trash/garbage containers.

FISHING LINE:

Fishing line can be dropped in the box on the Fishing/Crabbing Pier at 10th Street or dropped in the box at Fisherman's Headquarters, 9th Street. Call (609) 494-5739.

HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES:

Rechargeable Only. Drop off at Home Depot OR the Ocean County Southern Recycling Center (609) 978-0913.

BOAT COVERS:

Boat covers are recycled by the Borough. Drop off at the Recycling Center on Saturdays.

WOOD/CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:

All wood must be no longer than 4 foot and bundled no more than 12 inches. All nails must be removed. Where a **BUILDING PERMIT** is required, the homeowner and/or the contractor is responsible for disposal. The Borough must be supplied with record of type and quantities of debris and where it was disposed at - **IT'S THE LAW!**

CARPET:

Homeowners replacing carpet in an established home must cut and tie the carpet into 4 foot bundles not weighing more than 40 lbs. Carpet can be placed curbside from Labor Day through June.

VIOLATION TRASH/RECYCLING:

DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS IN THE RECYCLING CONTAINER. Do not use cardboard boxes or paper bags. (Everything must be in the container.) Do not put recycling into plastic bags. Place recycling directly into container. TRASH MEN WILL NOT PICK UP IF RECYCLING IS IN PLASTIC BAGS! Pizza boxes are considered trash.

OCEAN COUNTY SOUTHERN RECYCLING CENTER, RECOVERY ROAD, MANAHAWKIN, WILL ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING DAILY:

2. Auto & Boat Batteries
3. Motor Oil
4. Latex Paint
5. Leaves
6. Telephone Books
7. Cardboard

Located at Central Avenue and West 3rd Street. Hours of operation are: Saturday - 9:00 am to 12:00 noon (Subject to future change.)
