Bidders are required to comply with the requirements P.L. 1977, c.33; and P.L. 1999, c.238, "The Public Works Registration Act," if applicable.

The Minimum Wage rates, if applicable, for labor employed on these contracts shall be as specified in the "The New Jersey Prevailing Wage Rate Determination," of the New Jersey Department of Labor and Industry.

The Borough hereby reserves the right to consider the bids for sixty (60) days after the receipt thereof. The Borough further reserves the right, which is understood and agreed to by all bidders, to award the contract award to the lowest responsible bidder based on the lowest total bid amount or amount per item or items and to make such awards or take such action as may be in the best interest of the Township. The Borough further reserves the right to make multiple awards for this contract, to sever and make awards of all or part of any bid to one or more bidder, to reject any or all bids due to defects or failure to adhere to the specifications or for any reason, or to waive defects and accept any bid that in its judgment will be in the best interest of the Borough.
